- 3. Apply extra Potassium and Magnesium
- 4. Segregate dormant genera in bright dry area
- 5. Repot plants after flowering
- 6. Groom plants and flower spikes for holiday display

Display Table: Roy Krueger reviewed all the plants on the display table. Nice job, Roy.



She wished her Orchid Family a **Happy Holiday Season**, a prosperous and healthy New Year, and begged them to drive safely. See you all at the 2020 show.


