She received her high school degree from the Cali German School and was an exchange student in Claremont, CA where she graduated again at the St. Lucy's Priory High School. She went on to earn a Biology degree with an emphasis in Botany at the Universidad del Valle, Cali. Andrea than earned a Master's of Science with a major in Electron Microscopy and a minor in Virology from the University of Florida in Gainesville, FL. She worked as a research associate at the International Center for Tropical Agriculture in the Pastures Entomology Department and later in the Virology Unit. She has been a dedicated hobbyist orchid grower all of her life. Andrea is a board member and former president (1992 -1997) of the local orchid society, Asociación Vallecaucana de Orquideología, and a judge of the Colombian Orchid Committee.

Andrea has lectured about Colombian Orchids in Colombia, USA, Canada, Belgium, Italy, Ireland, Spain, Austria, Switzerland, Sweden, Nederland, Singapore, Ecuador, South Africa and Germany. With her husband, Juan Carlos Uribe, she has maintained her own orchid nursery since 1989. ORQUIDEAS DEL VALLE, which has grown to include two retail shops, an online shop, two nurseries, one warm growing and the other for cool growing plants plus laboratory facilities for seed flasking. ORQUIDEAS DEL VALLE has attended many National and International Shows, World Orchid Conferences and European Orchid Conferences lecturing, exhibiting and selling the beautiful and diverse orchid species from Colombia.
